

Message from BEFCU's CEO- March 16, 2020

Bourns Employees Federal Credit Union is closely monitoring information and reports about the Coronavirus (COVID-19) from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), World Health Organization (WHO), California state health officials, and local community health and governmental agencies to ensure that our actions are aligned with the latest recommendations.

We recognize the impact COVID-19 has had and continues to have on our members and our friends, families, and local communities at large; we also are aware of the uncertainty this health issue is having on everyone.

As a result, BEFCU has taken, and will continue to implement as necessary, a number of precautionary measures to ensure the health and safety of our members and staff.

At this time, we are maintaining normal business hours. Branches will remain open and continue with the normal operating hours (see website for hours of operation).

Branches are cleaned and sanitized regularly as part of our normal course of business. We have increased these efforts by continuously disinfecting surfaces that are frequent points of contact throughout the day.

We have advised our employees to limit close contact with others—that means we'll be greeting you with a wave instead of handshake for a while!

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home if you are not feeling well, particularly if you have a cough, fever or shortness of breath.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze, then throw the tissue in the trash and wash your hands.
